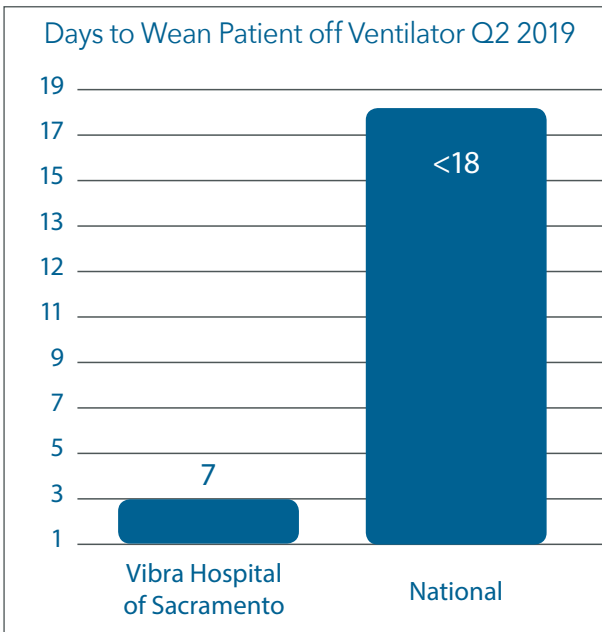

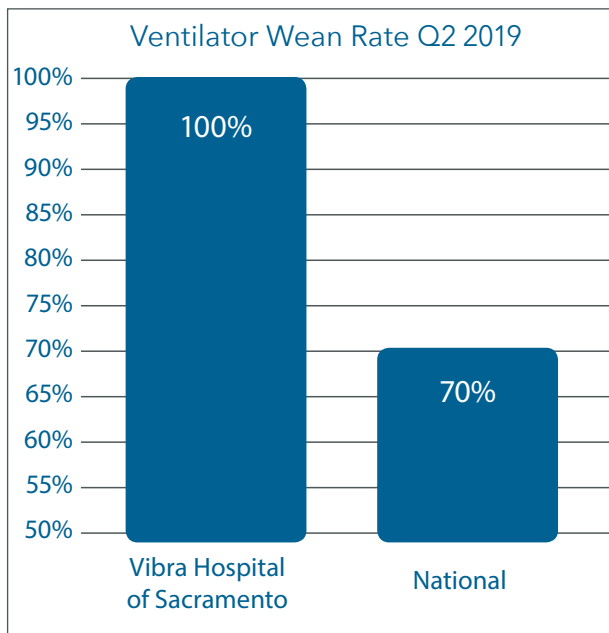

Respiratory Outcomes

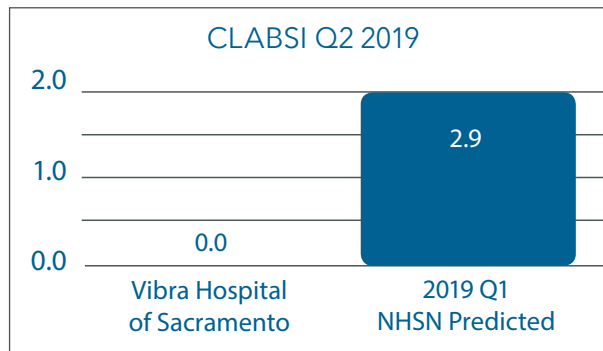


Definition= Average number of days to successfully wean a patient off the ventilator. Source= www.ltrax.com

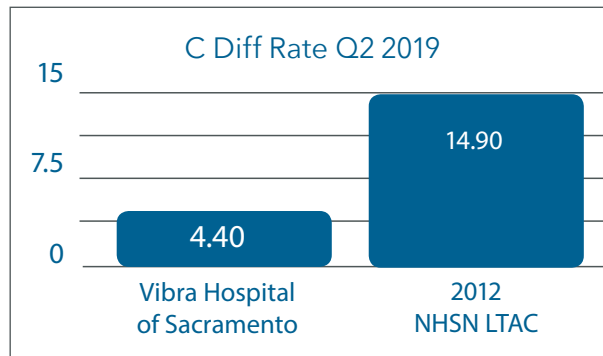


Definition= % of patients requiring mechanical ventilation upon admission and weaned off of the ventilator at time of discharge. Source= www.ltrax.com

Infection Control Measures

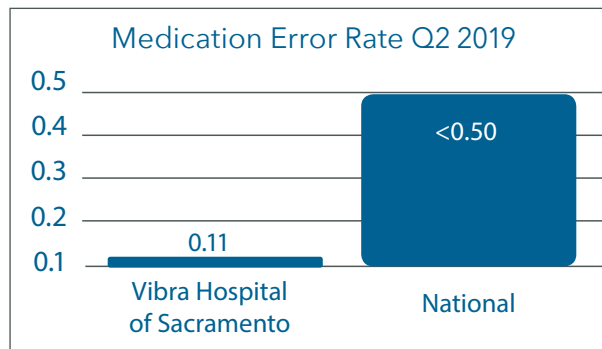


CLABSI: Central Line Associated Blood Stream Infection

 Source= National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN)



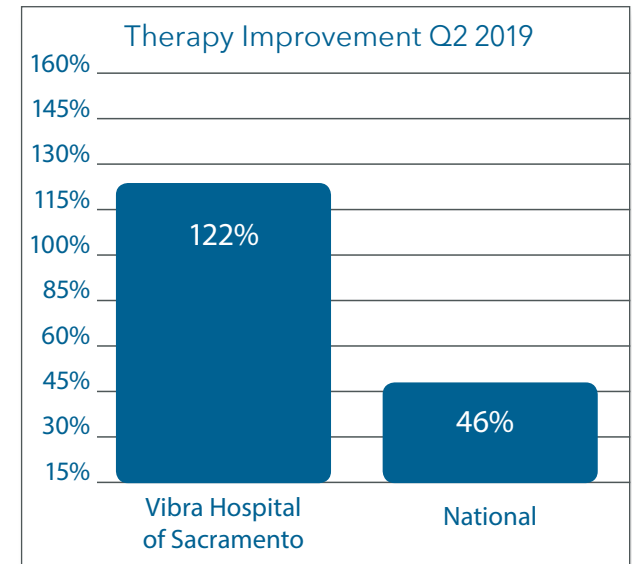
Definition = Occurance of C Diff per 10,000 patient days.

Medication Management



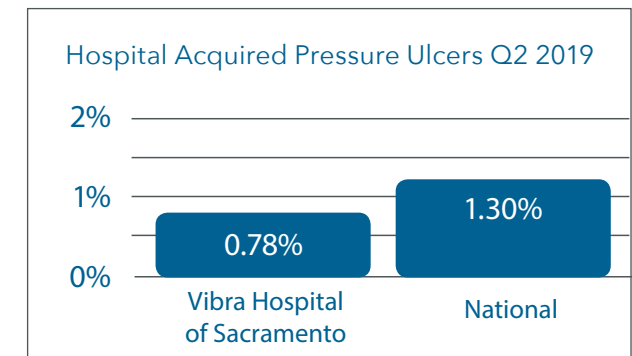
Definition = (Number of medication errors/number of doses dispensed) x 1000
